Introduction

IBWrite is used by teachers and students in schools offering the International Baccalaureate™ Experimental Sciences courses.

Approximately 2900 schools worldwide offer the IB Diploma Programme, which challenged us to produce a Terms of Use and Privacy Policy document that is relevant for all our users, regardless of geographic location.

We drafted our Privacy Policy with the stipulations of California's Online Privacy Protection Act of 2003^[1] in mind. As one of the stricter online privacy legislations available, we are able to provide IBWrite users with the most information on how we collect, store and use your information.

Privacy Policy

Data You Provide to Us

Teachers and schools. We collect information that identifies the school (such as country, IB code and name), the number of students in their Science programs and teacher names and emails. This information is used to issue invoices and create teacher accounts.

Students. We collect students' first and last name, emails and user-generated passwords when they create their IBWrite accounts. The students associate their accounts with a class and teacher, which links their personally identifiable information to their school and teacher's profile in our servers.

Who We Share your Data With

Your personally identifiable data will never be sold.

We share user data with selected third-party providers. This is necessary to deliver our services in an efficient manner. These providers are listed below, with information on how your data is used. If you wish to delete or modify the data you provided to us, please write to info@ibwrite.net



MailChimp

We use MailChimp to email active and prospective users. Data provided to us on the contact, purchase and account creation forms are uploaded and stored on MailChimp's servers.



PayPal

We use PayPal to send schools and teachers their subscription invoice. The teacher's email, first and last name and school name are saved in an address book within PayPal.



Google Sheets / Forms

We use Google Forms to collect teacher and school data in order to issue invoices.



Microsoft Azure

School, teacher and student information, including user-generated data and passwords, is stored on our Azure account. The IBWrite application is hosted here, so this is required to allow users to access the platform.

Data We Collect from You

We use cookies to remember your login details – that’s it! IBWrite will comply with your browser’s “Do Not Track” settings ([what is this?](#)).

The third-party service providers listed below collect your web traffic data (anonymously) when you visit IBWrite or watch our video tutorials. This information helps us understand trends and improve the quality of our platform. We are not able to identify you from this data.



YouTube

When teachers and students watch our exclusive video tutorials, YouTube collects information like the duration of the session, the device used and the browser being used.



Google Analytics

When you visit IBWrite.net, Google Analytics collects information such as the browser you are using, the language of your operating system and how long you stay on our site.

No third-party services keep collecting data after you visit IBWrite.

Terms of Service Permitted Use

Teachers and students must use IBWrite to complete the Internal Assessment in the subject for which their license was purchased.

Video tutorials and any support material provided within the platform must not be shared or distributed in any way, even for teachers and students who subscribe to IBWrite. These materials must be accessed through the student or teacher dashboards only.

All accounts are individual, and the login details must not be shared between students or teachers. Teachers can request the deletion of accounts by contacting us at info@ibwrite.net.

User-Created Data

The student remains the owner of all the work submitted to IBWrite, including graphs and data tables made by the student and uploaded to the platform.

The content created by students in the Internal Assessment writing process is visible only to the student and the teachers at the student's school.

Since we don't have access to this data, IBWrite may contact teachers to request copies of student work as a form of data collection to evaluate and improve our services. IBWrite may also request schools to submit their cohort's IA scores and complete end-of-program surveys for the same purposes.

Providing any of the above is optional. If samples are provided, all student, teacher and school identifiable information is removed, and the owner of the material (student) is granting all license rights to us. IBWrite can then re-purpose and distribute these reports (always anonymously) as copyrighted material, either as educational or commercial material.

To the best of our knowledge, IBWrite can help students and teachers manage and produce quality Internal Assessment reports for the International Baccalaureate Experimental Sciences courses.
